### Instructions for preparing apparatus

These instructions give details of the apparatus required by each candidate for each experiment in this paper. A summary of the questions that will be presented to the candidates is included, where appropriate, to allow the Biology teacher who is the supervisor to test the apparatus appropriately.

#### No access to the question paper is permitted in advance of the examination session.

If a candidate breaks any of the apparatus, or loses any of the material supplied, the matter should be rectified and a note made in the Supervisor's report.

It is assumed that the ordinary apparatus of a science laboratory will be available, including a supply of purified water (distilled or deionised).

If arrangements are made for different sessions for different groups of candidates, care must be taken to ensure that the different groups of candidates are effectively isolated so that **no information passes** between them.

Supervisors are advised to remind candidates that **all** substances in the examination should be treated with caution. Pipette fillers and safety goggles should be used where necessary.

**C** = corrosive substance

**F** = highly flammable substance

**H** = harmful or irritating substance

**O** = oxidising substance

T = toxic substance

# Instructions for preparing apparatus

#### For Question 1

Each candidate will require

- (a) 2 boiling tubes
- (b) 2 rubber stoppers that fit the boiling tubes, each fitted with a laboratory thermometer
- (c) hot water at 60 °C to 70 °C supplied in a polystyrene foam cup with lid labelled "hot water"
- (d) sufficient cotton wool to cover 1 boiling tube
- (e) test-tube rack or suitable support for two boiling tubes
- (f) timer/stop clock
- (g) 2 small-sized rubber bands
- (h) paper towel

#### For Question 2

- (a) paper towel
- (b) two peanut seeds, soaked for 24 hours, in a Petri dish labelled "C"
- (c) a maize seed, soaked for 24 hours, in a Petri dish labelled "D"
- (d) about 10 cm<sup>3</sup> ethanol in a suitable container with a dropper or pipette labelled "Ethanol"
- (e) two small test-tubes in a test-tube rack or a suitable support
- (f) a scalpel knife
- (g) a tile
- **(h)** labelling stickers (small size)
- (i) hand lens
- (j) a pair of forceps
- (k) access to water

**Note:** Supervisors are to place the hot water at almost boiling on the candidates' working stations just before the examination. The hot water should be provided in closed polystyrene foam cups and should be about ¾ full.

Information required from the Supervisor:

The Supervisor is asked to carry out the experiments and to enter the results on a spare copy of the examination paper, clearly marked 'Supervisor's Results' and showing the Centre number. This should be returned with the scripts. Failure to do so may cause the candidates to be penalised.
