0 marks: more than 3 errors of punctuation and/or spelling; AND/OR irrelevant to context; AND/OR not a proper sentence; and/or fewer than 12 or more than 20 words.

Absence of a full stop at the end should be considered as 1 punctuation error.

Absence of an upper case letter at the beginning should be considered as 1 punctuation error.

Benefits

2. Increase in academic results / motivation levels /increase reading /can make children sharper / mentally active /tough / mental strength

4. Enhance social skills / having fun and enjoying yourself / forget about work and commitments/ become sociable in an unstructured way
5. Helps to take off the edge of a stressful day

Disadvantages

6. Online attacks
7. Children exposed to less reputable sites / can access dangerous information
8. Addictive/ children lose study time / requires a lot of time

9. Breaks family relations

LANGUAGE (up to 4 marks)

0 marks: meaning obscure because of density of language errors and serious problems with expression / nothing of relevance

1 mark: expression weak / reliance on lifting without discrimination

2 marks: expression limited / some reliance on lifting from the original, but some sense of order

3 marks: expression good, with attempts to group and sequence ideas in own words

4 marks: expression very good; clear, orderly grouping and sequencing largely in own words.
